



Walking Points

Talk together about the glory of God's kingdom. -Psalm 145:11
Love the Lord your God and walk in all his ways. -Joshua 22:5

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Message: January 11, 2015 • Man the Lifeboats*

Main Message Text: Hebrews 10:24 - 25 (NIV)

Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Remember that we are defining LifeBoats as a group of friends who are committed to helping one another grow in Christ.

Questions for Reflection or Discussion

1. Let's get started by thinking about friendship. Who are your best friends? Tell a story about you and your friends, a funny story or an adventure (feel free to use your childhood friendships).
2. Why is the phrase "two fellows in the same ship" a good starting point in defining the word "fellowship"? Give some examples of how we use that word fellowship too lightly at church. How much stronger do you think the New Testament uses the word fellowship?
3. Friends enhance our lives, but being a part of a group of friends who have adopted the purpose of "spurring one another to grow in Christ" is life altering. In what ways can a group like that move you to be more like Christ?
4. What are the action points that you can take to surround yourself with friends that will help you to grow spiritually? If you already have such friends, how can you be more intentional to help one another grow in our faith walk?
